

Transcript of Interview of Robert Whitaker by CNN's Drew Griffin in Columbia, South Carolina June 19, 2015

Drew Griffin: The obvious first question: Do you know anything about this shooter in Charleston?

Robert Whitaker: No, I didn't even know that it was at a black church. I saw it yesterday morning on the -and I don't read the thing I think everybody knows that you don't read stuff. And it sounded like this guy... What they emphasized in that story was that his father had given him a gun. And so the gun control angle. I figured that was it, and I didn't see the rest of it.

Drew Griffin: Now that you've seen the rest of it, what are your thoughts?

Robert Whitaker: Like any other human being I don't like the idea of someone marching in and shooting people. But the solution according... You see these buzzards -you know, the SPLC and the gun control organizations and so forth- every time there's a tragedy they charge in there and raise money on it. Right now they're using it to attack the Confederate flag. I think the guy was wearing a Rhodesian flag. But it, you know, whatever they can... I got a... I was on the SPLC's mailing list for a while. They sent out one mailing to.. they were going to try to get more minorities in northern Idaho. This is their great cause. So, they're pretty desperate for something to raise money on.

Drew Griffin: You, um, you write a blog. And..

Robert Whitaker: I just read the news on..

Drew Griffin: No, but you write a blog.

Robert Whitaker: Yes. Since 1998.

Drew Griffin: And it deals with segregation issues..

Robert Whitaker: It deals, no because we can't. Our (motto?), the reason we're driving them nuts, our (motto?) is: we're not going to talk about any specifics until they stop acting like a mob.

Drew Griffin: They?

Robert Whitaker: The whole media, the SPLC, the whole crowd. When they start shrieking, it's like George Orwell's sheep in his Animal Farm. Somebody says something they don't like they start screaming "Two legs bad, four legs good!" It's a MOB. They're screaming. And they're after the money and they're buzzards, they're waiting for something like this to happen. So that then they can start screaming about something and that raises good money.

Drew Griffin: Well, Mr. Whitaker, this, this did happen and it seems like...

Robert Whitaker: There's going to be a LARGE number of murders this week, I can tell you that.

Drew Griffin: But there's very few murders where the shooter seems to want to start a race war. Which is what he apparently told the police. Very few shootings like that. And very few shootings where a young, white kid from a very white neighborhood goes down to Charleston South Carolina into a very black church and kills nine people.

Robert Whitaker: Yeah. What am I supposed to do about it?

Drew Griffin: Do you feel any responsibility towards that being part of...

Robert Whitaker: It's the SPLC that's always talking about how evil white people are.

Drew Griffin: But you don't see that (crosstalk) this person was visiting your blog, this person was visiting...

Robert Whitaker: I have no idea. They tried to pull that on me when they interviewed me one time, the SPLC. I said: "Come on man. You're a professional. That's the oldest (???) in the world." But, you know, I, my blog, I said the SPLC is ALWAYS talking about how evil white people are. I never heard of anybody going through say some black guy starts killing white people. Nobody ever talks about the police goes through their place and the list of publications they have. The mob. A bunch of buzzards.

Drew Griffin: What do you think about this particular person?

Robert Whitaker: I know nothing about him. What do you think about?

Drew Griffin: I'm asking you about his supposed cause to start a race war. Is that, I mean, is that in any way in line with anything that you might have?

Robert Whitaker: Nothing I said. In fact, I'm not even trying to offer a solution. What I'm saying is: we want to discuss it. That's why we only...

Drew Griffin: To discuss what?

Robert Whitaker: White genocide. The fact that only whites are targeted by diversity. That's why we, uh.. Only one.. When you talk about immigration we all know what you're talking about. And you do, too. White countries have to bring in large numbers of third world people. They have to assimilate with them. The mayor of Paris has a sign up that says "French women are for African men." The City of Paris put that up. (Some woman?) came along and put stuff in French about how, you know about how...

Drew Griffin: So you, I mean, you truly do believe that a quote unquote white race is under attack.

Robert Whitaker: Well, let me ask you quote unquote white race. Now, the same people who talk about white guilt...

Drew Griffin: I'm asking you about what (crosstalk)

Robert Whitaker: Let me finish my thought. I thought you were interviewing me? The same people who talk about white guilt, white people stole America and all those things then turn right around and say "What's white? What does that mean? White??" You know. And you just repeated it. If I talked about whites stole America, you'd know exactly what I was talking about. But now since, you know, the line is- it depends on, you know, which phase you're in. But you follow right along. So called white race.

Drew Griffin: I'm just trying to figure out what you...

Robert Whitaker: No you're not.

Drew Griffin: Anyway, I am. The, the shooter said to police -that was his report to police- that he felt that his white community, white race was under attack. Do you feel that same way is what I'm asking. In whatever way you define the white race.

Robert Whitaker: Uh, we, as I have said, immigration is only pushed on white countries. Everybody knows that. Not on Japan. Not on Taiwan. And the answer I usually get is: "duh." You know. But the fact is we all know that. When you talk about diversity, you're always talking about white people. Now, if any other race were targeted that way, there'd be some question about it. But you say that the press or the (?????????) they never heard this before.

Drew Griffin: I just heard it from you. I'm going to ask the question again because you answered the question by talking about Japan and Taiwan. I'm asking you again. Do you feel the white race in the United States (????????) more specific is under attack.

Robert Whitaker: The idea is to get rid of us. Yes, that's called genocide. Their aim, they talk about a brown world. They're not talking about the world. They're talking about assimilation in white countries and only white countries.

Drew Griffin: And what is, in your viewpoint, the solution to that?

Robert Whitaker: I am not allowed to talk about it. What I've got is a mob screaming "racist, Nazi!".

Drew Griffin: So, you won't talk about your solution?

Robert Whitaker: I can't.

Drew Griffin: Because?

Robert Whitaker: Because I'm not allowed. I mean, if I say anything these people start screaming "racist, Nazi, white supremacist!" whatever. This is like any other group of people who suppress free speech. They don't say: "We're suppressing free speech." They just call you names and threaten you. And you know damn well I get threats and I get, you know, I get attacked. And you know it very well. I mean..

Drew Griffin: Well, the offensive question which I will ask you. You probably are ready to...

Robert Whitaker: No, ask me. I believe in free speech. (crosstalk)

Drew Griffin: If this kid -right?- believes the same thing you believe. That white America is under attack. And he pro-actively decided to go out and do something about that...

Robert Whitaker: That's the way you think.

Drew Griffin: I'm asking you.

Robert Whitaker: Do you go shoot up churches?

Drew Griffin: Of course not, I don't.

Robert Whitaker: I don't, either. Then why are you asking me?

Drew Griffin: I'm asking you if you think...

Robert Whitaker: I don't think walking into a church and shooting people is a good idea. I don't think it's that complicated. Is that really a complicated concept to you?

Drew Griffin: So, you don't believe there's any connection (crosstalk)

Robert Whitaker: I have no idea what's going on in this kid's mind in Charleston South Carolina. Look, everybody talks about income distribution. Where the poor are getting poorer and the rich are getting richer. That's what Stalin talked about. Does that mean that the communist (???)? Every communist that ever killed somebody that you're abetting them? You don't have to answer me

Drew Griffin: (???)

Robert Whitaker: Nobody does. But what I'm saying is they used to do that. Anybody who talks about income distribution is a communist. Now anybody who talks about what

we all know all this (???) only to white people.

Drew Griffin: Why do you still write the blog? You've been writing it for so long.

Robert Whitaker: I've been teaching my people how to get as much of our message as we can. We want the right of Americans to talk about our race being singled out. Period. That's it. But in order to say that, it's really hard to get that, that message out. Because, uh, the media don't want to talk about it. They have their point of view and CNN has its point of view. United States is not as bad as Europe but you keep using screams and labels and blaming anybody who disagrees with you for murders. You can get the Soviet Union (???)

Drew Griffin: How many followers do you have on your blog? Any idea?

Robert Whitaker: I can't keep up with that. My last technical stuff was I had earphones and a code key in my hand in the fifties (???) a HAM. And we don't keep up with that. We do have... they are screaming a word. Trying to keep them from getting off on all these other issues (???). You know, conspiracies and all that stuff and just talk about- we have a right to speak. And talk about this is only aimed at white people. Period. We only get a minute to say that, you know. (???) It's all over now. In Paris (???) That's why I'm a (???). This is my entire message. To stop being a mob.
